2) An offender must ~~==~~

(a) ~~be of good behaviour and not~~ behave well and in a way ~~which undermines that~~ supports the purpose of the offender being on licence ~~period~~;

(b) not commit any ~~offence~~ crime;

(c) keep in touch with the supervising officer ~~in accordance with instructions given as~~ instructed by the supervising officer;

(d) ~~receive visits from~~ meet with the supervising officer ~~in accordance with instructions~~ given by at any place the supervising officer specifies, including meeting the supervising officer where the offender lives;

(e) ~~reside permanently~~ stay at an address approved by the supervising officer and ~~obtain the prior~~ get permission ~~off from~~ the supervising officer ~~for any if they want to stay of at~~ another address for one or more nights ~~at a different address~~;

(f) ~~not undertake~~ tell the supervising officer about any new work, or ~~a particular~~ type of work, ~~unless it is approved by the supervising officer they want to do,~~ and ~~notify~~ get the approval of the supervising officer ~~in advance of any proposal to undertake before~~ starting the work ~~or a particular type of work~~;

(g) ~~not travel outside the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man except with the prior permission of your supervising officer or for the purposes of immigration deportation or removal~~;

~~[F1~~ (h) g) tell the supervising officer if they ~~use a name which is different to have a~~ passport and give the supervising officer any details about the passport that the ~~name or names which appear on their licences~~ supervising officer asks for;

(i) ~~tell~~ (h) get permission from the supervising officer if they ~~change or add any want to~~ apply for a new passport;

(i) get permission from the supervising officer if they want to leave the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man. This condition does not apply if the offender is being deported or removed for immigration purposes;

(j) tell the supervising officer about any names they use that are different to the names on their licence;

(k) tell the supervising officer if their contact details change, including any ~~phone~~ telephone number or email: address.”
